- Develop an individual high school education plan

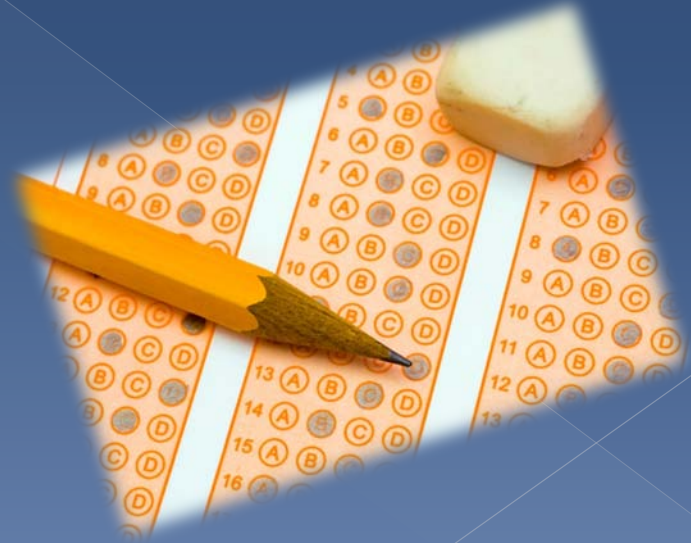
